

Deeds of Love Ministry (DOLM) – Report 2021

A. DOLM'S PAST

Since its inception, DOLM has operated as a centralized entity as a ministry of the Baptist Union of Southern Africa (BUSA). The ministry exists to facilitate and mobilize compassionate ministry through the local church.

B. DOLM'S FUTURE

With the restructuring of the BUSA, it was necessary to also give careful attention with regard to how DOLM will operate in the future. There has since been two changes: a) DOLM will in future operate under the direct banner of the BUSA Missions Department. This is important as Compassionate Care and Missions/Evangelism Ministries are inseparable in seeing the Kingdom of God established through our outreach efforts.

b) DOLM has been restructuring to function as regional networks. In June this year the first regional network commenced in the Western Cape. Over the next two years we will introduce similar networks in each of the provinces across the country.

C. DOLM'S activities mobilized through the local church:

- Child Protection Week in May each year.
- World Weekend of Prayer for Vulnerable Children in June each year.
- Orphan Sunday in November each year
- Foster Care.
- Schools' Prayer Network
- Morocco Ministry
- Baptist Refugee Ministry
- Disaster Relief Ministry
- Training & Development

These activities and ministries are not conclusive. We are also willing to assist with any local church ministry project that you have operative or wish to launch.

Please continue to pray for us during this season of the pandemic as it has certainly
